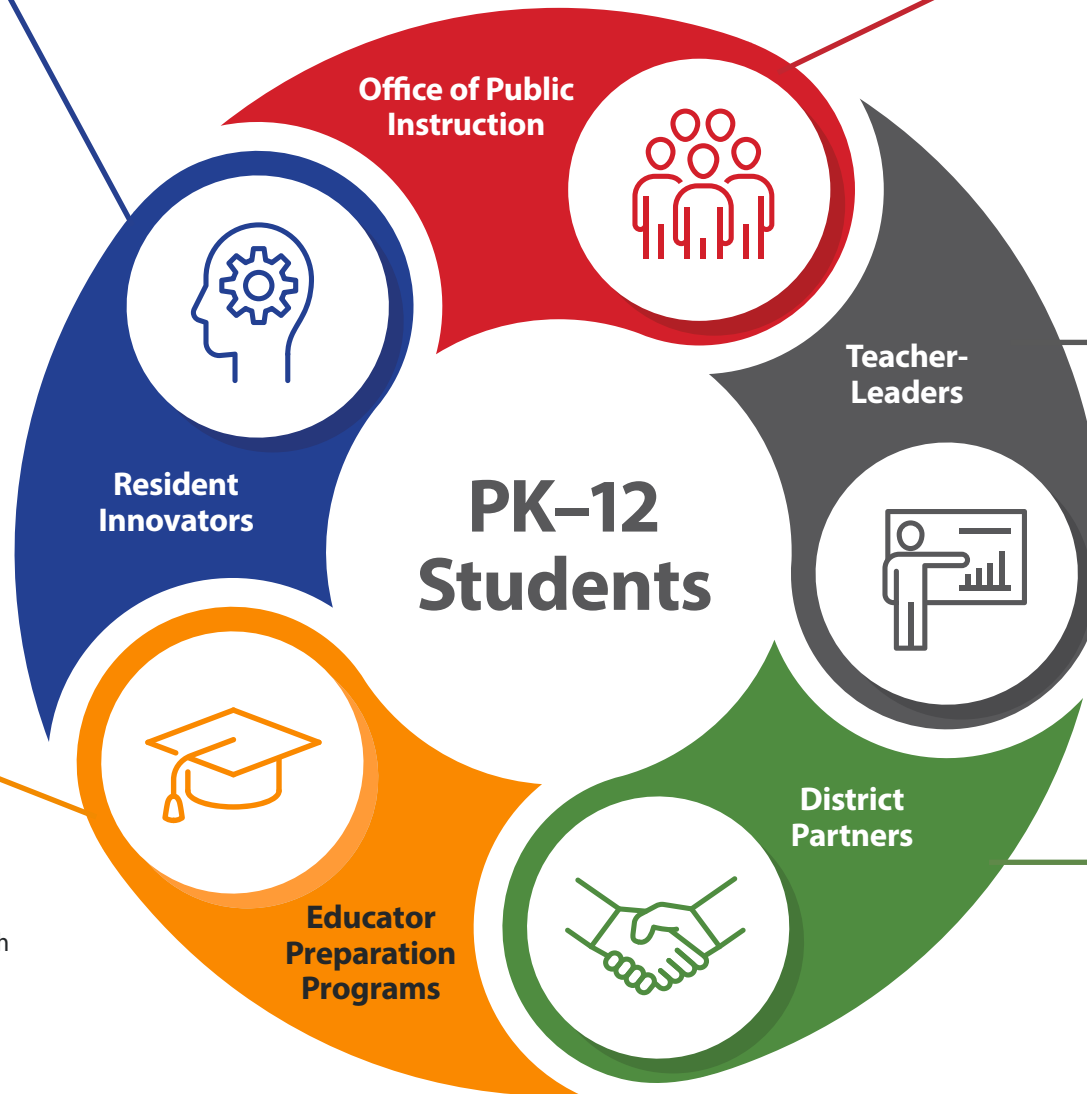


Roles within the Montana Teacher Residency Program

- Undergraduate, or Masters student upon approval, education member who will student teach for a full academic school year to become a better prepared and effective teacher following the program and who is more inclined to remain in the teaching profession in Montana

- Participate in a Residency Program orientation and Learning Labs throughout the year
- Be matched with a school that provides high-quality and supportive experience
- Receive a monthly stipend, partial tuition waiver, and housing assistance during their placement in exchange for committing to teach in a Montana District for 3 years within five years of the completion of the program

- Postsecondary program intended to lead to teacher licensure that is accredited or recognized by the Montana Board of Public Education
- Recruit and choose Residents through a competitive selection process
- Provide flexible course delivery to support Residents
- Provide Residents with a partial last-dollar tuition grant
- Distribute an adjunct faculty partial stipend to Teacher Leaders and a monthly stipend to Residents
- Participate in program evaluations



- Administrator of the Montana Teacher Residency Program
- Sponsors professional learning opportunities for Teacher Leaders and Learning Labs for Residents
- Recruit districts in consultation with district and college/university partners
- Provides stipends for Residents and Teacher Leaders

- An experienced classroom teacher who is selected for a full-year mentorship of a Resident
- Provides coaching and modeling of instructional best practices
- Share expertise and guidance with the Resident
- Participate in professional learning opportunities offered by OPI
- Receive a stipend twice during the academic school year

- School district in Montana, partnering with EPPs, to provide Residents with a year-long student teaching experience in a manner that meets the criteria of supervised teaching experiences
- Provide housing assistance as agreed upon by the Resident and district
- Engage in yearly evaluations to provide feedback and help refine the program
