Participants will also learn about the leadership and professional growth opportunities available for themselves and their students.

Montana's CTE Specialists have designed the workshop to focus on fundamentals of Career & Technical Education, funding at the federal and state levels, professional organizations, curriculum resources, program standards and guidelines, and Career & Technical Student Organizations.
