Renewal Unit Provider System Overview

The Renewal Unit Provider System is used by approved renewal unit providers to report renewal unit activities to the Office of Public Instruction. The data gathered in the system includes the activity title, the date(s) and location(s) of the activity, and the number of participants. Certificates are generated from the information entered into the Renewal Unit Provider System by the approved renewal unit provider.

The management of the Renewal Unit Provider System and its processes transitioned from the Licensure division to the Professional Learning team within the Standards, Instruction, and Professional Learning unit in the Teaching and Learning Division during the summer of 2020. Additional information related to Professional Learning and the Renewal Unit Provider System can be found on the OPI Professional Learning website.

Provider Criteria and Requirements

Per the <u>Administrative Rule of Montana 10.57.216 Approved Renewal Activity</u>, "organizations wishing to offer professional development activities for the award of renewal units must receive approval from the Superintendent of Public Instruction prior to offering activities." Status as an approved provider will continue as long as the provider meets the following guidelines by:

- Providing activities deemed appropriate for professional development in compliance with ARM <u>10.55.714</u> and <u>10.57.215</u>,
- Following the renewal unit activity certificate reporting process, and
- Maintaining records of all professional development activity for which renewal unit certificates were awarded for five years following the date of completion.

All providers are assigned provider categories for reporting. The categories are: County Superintendents, Government Agencies, Professional Education Associations, School Districts, Tribal, and Universities and Colleges.

Data Analysis

The data for this report includes all renewal unit activities entered into the Renewal Unit Provider System with an end date between July 1, 2019 and June 30, 2020 (FY2020). Professional learning providers that did not issue OPI Renewal Unit Certificates during the time period were omitted from this report. For a complete list of approved OPI Renewal Unit Providers, please see the <u>Approved Renewal Unit Provider Directory</u>.

As of the date of this report, providers are required to report the following data points to the OPI:

- Title of the Activity
- Instructor's Name
- Starting and Ending Dates of the Activity
- Location of the Activity
- Number of Hours
- Number of Certificates Issued

The current data points collected in the Renewal Unit Provider System is limited, and an upgrade is necessary in order to better align the data points with current Administrative Rules of Montana. The Renewal Unit Provider


System will be upgraded in during the fiscal year of 2021 to require approved renewal activity providers to provide a brief description of the renewal unit activity per <u>Administrative Rule of Montana 10.57.216 Approved Renewal Activity</u>. The enhancements will allow Professional Learning staff to analyze the data to better identify professional learning gaps and trends across the state. The enhancements and revised processes will also improve data reporting accuracy. Fiscal 2020 Provider Report Summary


A total of 312 providers conducted 3,864 renewal unit activities. The 3,864 activities were cumulatively worth 26,705 renewal units. The number of certificates issued throughout FY2020 was 68,729. School districts coordinated and provided the majority of the renewal unit activities, renewal units, and certificates issued in the state, however, the OPI Teacher Learning Hub issued the most (7,384) renewal unit certificates of any individual provider between July 1, 2019 and June 30, 2020. The <u>Teacher Learning Hub Annual Report</u> can be referenced for additional information related to their renewal unit activities. The tables in the Appendix contain individual provider data, such as the number of renewal unit activities, the number of renewal units, and the number of certificates issued per provider. The following graphs demonstrate the percentage of overall renewal unit activities, number of renewal units, and the number of certificates issued per provider category.

Renewal Unit Activities Per Provider Category

Most of the renewal unit activities in the state are provided or coordinated by schools and school districts. School Districts provided the most renewal unit activities at 41.9%. Professional Education Associations provided 33.7%. Government Agencies, including the OPI and the Teacher Learning Hub provided 18.6% of the activities. Universities and Colleges provided 5.4% and County Superintendents provided 0.4% of the overall renewal unit activities.



Renewal Units Issued Per Provider Category




School Districts issued the majority of the renewal units. 37.4% of the overall renewal units issued were from school districts, with 30.4% of the renewal units issued coming from Professional Education Associations. Government agencies, including the OPI and the Teacher Learning Hub issued 23.3% of the renewal units, and Universities and Colleges provided 8.4%. 0.5% of the renewal units were provided by County Superintendents.

Certificates Issued Per Provider Category

School districts issued 40.2% of the certificates in FY2020. Professional Education Associations issued 29.5% of the certificates, and Government Agencies, including the OPI and the Teacher Learning Hub, issued 25.6%. Universities and Colleges issued 4.5%, with Country Superintendents issuing the remaining 0.2%.

Percentage of Certificates Issued Per Provider Category



The renewal unit provider data for FY2020 demonstrates how integral school districts are in determining the renewal unit activities that educators need to improve their practice. The upgrades to the Renewal Unit Provider System will improve our understanding of the renewal unit activities offered across the state, thus positively impacting future strategic planning at the state and local level. We look forward to continued conversations related to professional learning and renewal units.
