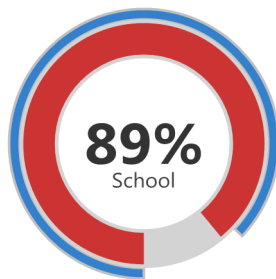

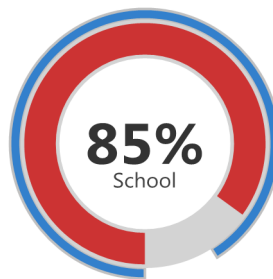
### Student Progress

% of students graduating high school in four years



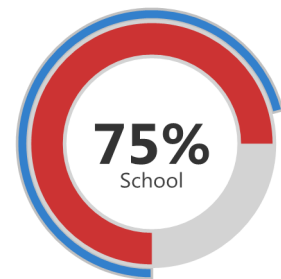

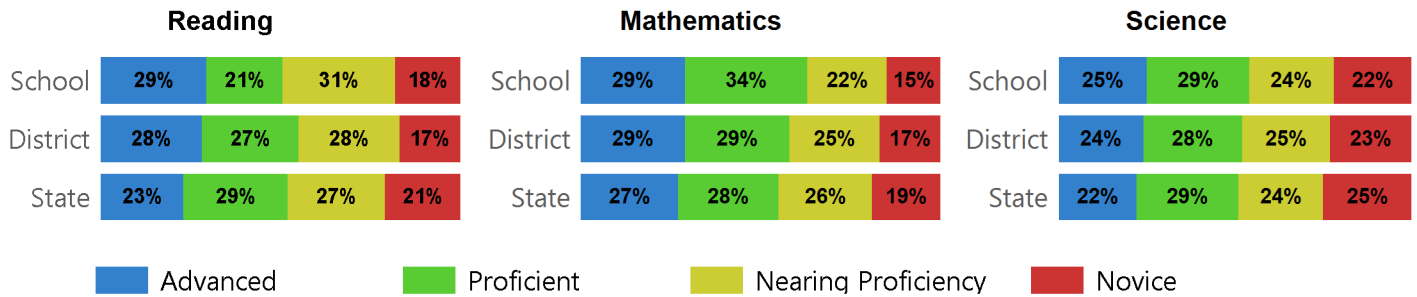

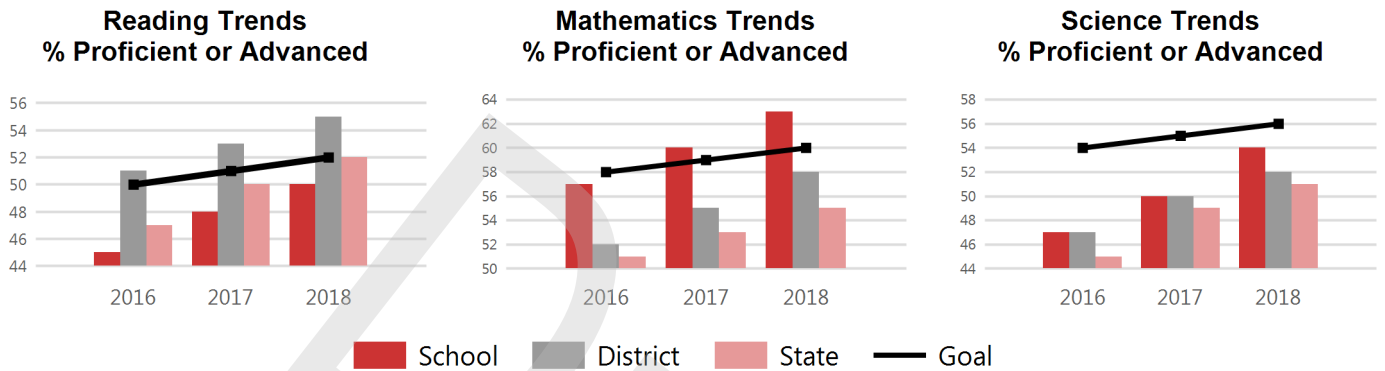

## School Finance
