

The graphics that follow attempt to provide users with a visual of the relationships of all of the TEAMS related data collections and a flow chart of the TEAMS process.

In the **TEAMS Relationships** graphic users can see that information we generate from our new Montana State Educator Information System (MSEIS) will be used in four major areas where OPI needs to this information to complete its work and processes related to these areas.


Terms of Employment (TOE) data that is provided by school districts will complete the data set for some of the information MSEIS has and will be used to support other processes. Specific to schools/districts and the accreditation portion of TEAMS, TOE data will be used to prepopulate some sections of this part of TEAMS. TOE is primarily a requirement of SB329 from 62<sup>nd</sup> Legislature (2011) which was codified in MCA 20-9-104 Transparency and public availability of public school performance data -- reporting -- availability for timely use to improve instruction and will be used to produce compensation expenditure reports as required under this statute.

The **T**erms of **E**mployment, **A**ccreditation, and **M**aster **S**chedule graphic displays some of the same information noted above in more of a linear/processes manner that also represents the relationships of the data collections in a dependency view. For example the Teacher-Class data is dependent upon the entry of TOE data before this part of the TEAMS process can move forward.
