## 2021 OPI Agency Legislation Requests

- MCA 20-9-368: Special Education appropriation to become part of BASE Aid to ensure stable funding for our at-risk students (Legislative Finance Committee subcommittee on Education): 2023 Biennium = \$5.21 million these assume inflationary increases of FY22 = 2.16% & FY23 2.26% and are subject to change once the CPI is set in July.
- MCA 20-7-403: Funding for education of children in in-state children's psychiatric hospitals and residential treatment programs (Legislative Finance Committee subcommittee on Education): 2023 Biennium: \$1.6 million
- MCA 20-9-314/534: Updates to the Broadband for Montana Schools program including extending the sunset date for utilization of existing funds and alternative methods of administration to better serve schools (Energy and Telecommunications Interim Committee)

- MCA 20-7-1602: Adjustments to the Transformational Learning Act
- MCA 20-1-101: Definition of student proficiency and pupil
- MCA 20-7-305/320: Increase student engagement in Career and Technical Student Organizations
- MCA 20-9-323: Establishing ending fund balance limits
