

Final Allocations for ARP-HCY II

ARP-HCY II Allocations were distributed to 32 school districts across the state. Districts were invited to apply for grant due to "significant concentrations" of students identified as homeless during the 2020-2021 school year although they did not receive McKinney-Vento funds. Districts received the full allocation the first year.
