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Notes for Family & Consumer Sciences Education-Related Courses

All Middle School/Junior High course must be coded using the Prior to Secondary Course section (p 1-20); do not use codes for Secondary Courses.

Course without Endorsement identified can be taught by any area of endorsement.

- If courses within one of the FCS Education-related subject areas and taught by a FCS Education Endorsed Teacher (23S FCS, 23S CA) course will count for CTE credit
- For Example—22101 Leadership and 22151 Career Exploration (p 75)

72206 Life Skills (prior to secondary, pg 20) and 22206 Life Skills (secondary, pg 76) is a FCS course, not a Special Education Course.

Schools are not required to change local District/School course titles or course descriptions to match the OPI Montana K-12 Course Codes.
