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Checklist for HiSET Option Program Testing

A student in the HiSET Option Program has participated in preparation for this test and is, and will continue to be, a full-time student. Taking the HiSET test is an alternative graduation path therefore there are specific requirements that must be met for this exception to test.

- The HiSET Option Program students must take the HiSET pretests before taking the actual test. The classroom teacher will use these tests to determine if the student is academically prepared to test.
- The Permission to Test Waiver form must be signed by the student's parents. If the student is 18 or is an emancipated minor, they can sign for themselves. Emancipated minors must have documentation to support their status.
- The program coordinator must register the students online for the HiSET test. Of special note is the inclusion of the state ID in the background section of the registration. The state ID is **Options** plus the Student ID number. Student IDs should be entered in the same area as the unique identifier. Students are assigned an ETS ID number and that too is recorded on the above waiver.
- The HiSET Option Program Coordinator submits the waiver to the state HiSET Option Program Specialist before testing. He/she will, in-turn, sign and return the form to the school so that the students can present proper documentation when they test.
- Electronic submissions are acceptable.
- Students must report to the test center with the waiver form, proper identification and test center fee (if applicable).
