Cigarettes **Smokeless Tobacco Electronic Vapor Products** 34% had ever tried cigarette smoking 7% of students had used chewing tobacco, snuff, dip, snus, or 11% had first tried cigarette smoking before age 13 dissolvable tobacco products on school years property during the past 30 days 3% of students had smoked cigarettes on 20 or more of the past 30 days 47% of students had ever used electronic vapor products 2% of students are daily smokers (each of past 30 days) Among current smokers, 5% had smoked more than 10 7% of electronic vapor product users got their own cigarettes per day (past 30 days) products by buying them in a store such as a convenience store, supermarket, discount store, gas 55% of current smokers tried to quit smoking during the station, or vape store. past 12 months
