comments that dual-credit offerings are preferred. There were also a number of comments

regarding broadening offerings for students of the school. A summary of suggestions are attached

with highlighting of items that support the continuation of dual-credit classes. Minutes of the

February 13, 2017 School Board Meeting are attached.

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Unofficial minutes of the February 13, 2017 School Baoard Meeting are attached. Official board minutes will be sent once approved at the March meeting. Official minutes of the April 28, 2014 Special Meeting are attached when the original administrative restructuring took place.

5. Describe the variance requested.

The Darby School District currently has two full-time principals and a 0.75 Superintendent. This was a change in 2014 to ensure the district had a highly qualified math teacher who could continue to teach the dual-credit math classes. The district's other certified math teacher with a Master's degree retired in the spring of 2014. In the 2013/14 school year the district had a superintendent/principal and a full-time principal for 2.0 FTE. To make the superintendent available to teach the dual-credit math classes the administrative team was increased to 2.75 FTE. In 2014 the district had less than 30 FTE, but due to increase in enrollment in the elementary and Special Education Dept the FTE increased during the 2016/17 school year to over 30. We believe having 2.75 administrators better serves the students of our district, so we are asking for a variance to this standard. According to 10.55.704 and 10.55.705 our district should have a full-time superintendent and 1.5 full-time principals. We have more administrative FTE than required in total, and are confident all social and academic aspects of students and staff can be met under these conditions.

6. Provide a statement of the mission and goals of this proposed variance.

The Darby School District is commited to offering a rigorous curriculum to our students which includes dual-credit classes. This variance will allow us to continue offering dual credit math to our students until the other certified math teacher earns enough graduate credits to teach the dual-credit class.

7. List specific measurable objectives that demonstrate the proposed variance will meet or exceed the results under the current standard(s).

The Administrative Team of Darby Public Schools will meet all required duties and responsibilities as prescribed by the Office of Public Instruction, the Collective Baragaining Agreement with the Darby Federation of Teachers and Darby Support Staff in a timely and responsible manner throughout the duration of this initial variance timeline.

8. What data or evidence will be gathered to document progress toward meeting the measurable objectives?

Each spring we will review our completion of required tasks and ensure we have met all timelines and administrative duties, if needed this documentation will be provided to show evidence of meeting or exceeding the standard.

9. In what way does this variance meet the specific needs of the students in the school(s)?



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Darby students needs are met by continuing to offer dual-credit math classes. Top math students in our school graduate high school with 6 college credits. This gives them a head start in college to increase their chances of success. The variance will also ensure the well-being of all students in the district will be met by having more administration than required.

10. Describe how and why the proposed variance would be:

a. Workable.

The district has been operating effectively for three school years with a part-time superintendent/math teacher. A slight increase in FTE has not affected our ability to carry on the necessary business of the school. Having 2.75 administrative FTE gives more supervision to students and teachers.

b. Educationally sound.

Darby students have been successful in dual-credit offerings over the past three years. This variance will allow that to continue. We have enough administrative staff to ensure the needs of all staff and students will be met.
