

Guidance Document CARES - State School Emergency Relief Fund

<u>Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES) - State School Emergency Relief Fund</u> is a Federal distribution for school emergency relief passed through the OPI. All funding provided for from the CARES Act *"may only be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus."* For additional information about allowable expenses click HERE.

Eligible Expenditures can be retro-actively coded back to March 13, 2020.

The application for these funds will be available to public school districts through the E-Grants System of OPI.
