These are a coordinated set of activities that are designed to focus on improving the academic and functional achievement of the child with a disability to facilitate the child's movement from school to post-school. They are based on the individual child's needs, taking into account the child's strengths, preferences, and interests.

The IEP for each child with a disability must include all needed transition services, as identified by the IEP team, regardless of whether the school district or some other agency will provide those services.

Some examples of transition services are:

- Assisting the student with signing up for ACT/SAT
- Assisting the student in college preparation
- Assisting the student with job skills
- Assisting the student in filling out a resume or job application
- Providing job experiences for the student
- Assisting the student with job skills
- Providing community-based experiences for the student
- Assisting the student with understanding his/her disability
- Assisting the student and parent in contacting VR or someone from an adult service such as DDP or Mental Health
- Assisting the student in studying for a driver's exam

If an outside agency is involved in the student's life, and the district invites them to the IEP meeting. The district needs to complete form for the outside agency to participate. And the form must be signed by the adult student, parent or the guardian giving permission for the outside agency's participation at the meeting.
