

Multi State Alternate Assessment (MSAA) Training Information and Resources

What is Required:

System Test Administrators (STCs) must complete the MSAA Test Administration Training for Test Coordinators found on the <u>MSAA System</u>.

Test Administrators (TAs) must complete the Online MSAA Test Administration Training Modules for Test Administrators and complete the final quiz with at least an 80% accuracy score. MSAA TA Training Modules can be found on the <u>MSAA System</u>.

Completion of the MontCAS Test Security readings and tasks as described on the OPI Test Security webpage.

Completion of the role-specific Roles and Responsibilities for Test Security Information test security agreement per OPI published guidance.

How Often Is It Required?

Completion of both the TA and the STC training is an annual requirement.

How Long on Average Does It Take?

Each training (the TA training modules and the STC training) take about 2.5 hours.
