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**Title I Schools in Improvement, Corrective Action, or Restructuring  
 Number and Percent of Title I Schools (by School District) That Made  
 Above Average Gains In Math  
 Based on 2009 Statewide Assessments**

This report provides the average statewide school gain in the "all students" category and the average statewide school gain for each student subgroup (as under section 1111(b)(2)(C)(v) of the ESEA) on the State assessments in math. For the State and each LEA in the State, it provides the number and percentage (including numerator and denominator) of Title I schools in improvement, corrective action, or restructuring, that have made progress (as defined in this notice) on State assessments in math in the last year. This information is publically reported in compliance with Montana's application for State Fiscal Stabilization Funds (Indicators (d)(1) and (d)(2)).

Minimum n=30 for each student group. Gains for schools with fewer than 30 students are not included in this report.

27 Title I schools in improvement, corrective action, or restructuring had an above average gain in math for every reported student group. These schools represent 20% of all Title I schools in improvement, corrective action, or restructuring.

For example, in the Lodge Grass Elementary district, one of the two schools in that district had a greater gain in reading in each qualifying student group than the statewide average school gain.

Student groups include All Students, Limited English Proficient, Economically Disadvantaged, Students with Disabilities, American Indian/Alaskan Native, Hispanic, and White. There are three other student groups (Asian, Black and Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander) that did not have sufficient numbers to be included in the calculation.
