WHAT TO BRING TO YOUR ADMISSION INTERVIEW

The following documents are **mandatory** for you to have at the time you meet with an Admissions Counselor for your Job Corps Admissions Interview. If you do not have all the required documents your interview will not be conducted. If you have any questions regarding these documents contact the Admissions Counselor above for clarification prior to your appointment.

- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate
- Photo ID
- Guardianship paperwork (if applicable)
- Immunization Records (last school you attended will have these if you do not have them)
- High School Transcripts/Diploma/GED Transcript
- Court Check for the past 3 years (get this from your County Court house. If you are 18 or 19 you will need a check from Juvenile Court as well)
- A List of 4 Alternate Contacts (Names, Address, Phone Numbers must be included for each)
- Current Income Verification (i.e. Pay stubs, W2 form, Receipt of Medicaid or Food Stamps)
- I-94 Alien Registration (required if not a legal US resident)/Permanent Resident Card/Unexpired passport with I-94
- Health Insurance cards (if covered by health insurance)
- Child Care information for any dependent children (if you are a parent)

Once you have acquired all the documents above please call the Admissions Counselor to schedule your interview. If you are a minor your legal guardian must be present at your interview to sign you in.
