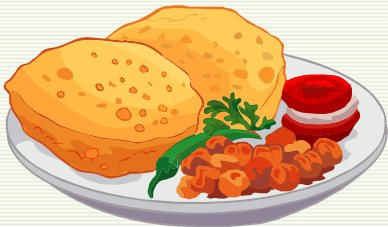

Quick Reference Guide:

FRAM: Direct Entry

This guide will help districts navigate the new FRAM module in Campus for the entry of Free/Reduced Meal Status for students.

This guide is designed to help districts navigate the new FRAM module in Infinite Campus. The FRAM module replaces the entry of Free/Reduced Meal Status on the student's enrollment record with a more comprehensive entry in the FRAM module. This guide outlines the process for the direct entry of FRAM data in AIM.



Before beginning, consider the following:

1. What is FRAM and why are we using it?

- The FRAM module was created in response to requests from Districts and States for a more comprehensive way to track changes to a student's Meal Status. *page 2*

2. What information is required and where do I get it?

- Districts must enter the student's Eligibility, Certification Type, Start Date and End Date. The information is collected as part of the application process at the district level. *page 2*

3. How do I verify the data I have entered?

- Districts may use Ad Hoc Reports to verify the entry of Free/Reduced Meal Status for students. *page 4*

FRAM MODULE

The Free/Reduced Meal Status field in the student enrollment record only captured information as of a specified date. If the information changed at any time during the year, no record was created to capture that change.

The new **FRAM** module allows districts to track changes to the Free/Reduced Meal status throughout the year.

In this example, the **Meal Status** for the 10-11 year shows *R: Reduced*. The **FRAM** module, however, shows the student as *F: Free* for the first semester and *R: Reduced* for the second.

NOTE: Meal Status is no longer entered in the student enrollment. All Free/Reduced Meal Status information **must** be entered through the **FRAM** module.

This information is collected as part of a student's Free/Reduced Meal application or is included in a direct certification file sent to the district by the Department of Public Health and Human Services.

Certified Type is a record of how the determination was made.

NOTE: **Certified Type** is not required for State Reporting purposes. The OPI recommends defaulting students to "Income" unless the district chooses to enter **Certified Type**.

Year should be set to the current year, **11-12**.

Start Date is the first date of eligibility.

End Date is the last date of eligibility.

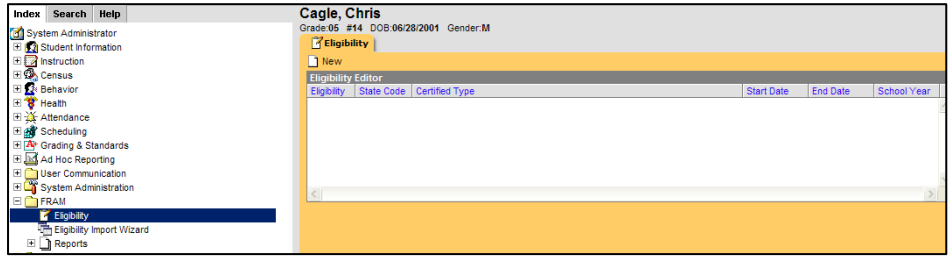
ENTERING FRAM DATA

Choose **Year 11-12** and a school. Click the **Search** tab. **Search for a: Student**. Click **Go**.

A list of student enrolled in that school for the 11-12 year will appear under **Search Results**.

From the **Index**, expand **FRAM** and select **Eligibility**.

Click the **Search** tab. Select the first student in the **Search Results** to enter Free/Reduced Meal data for.

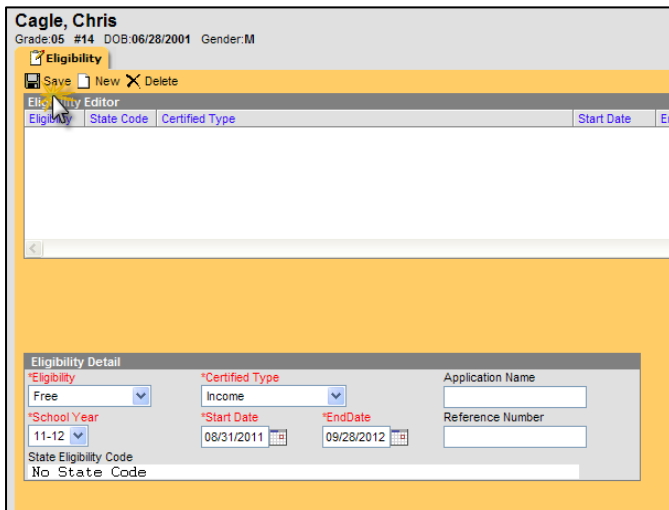


Click **New**.

Enter **Eligibility**, **Certified Type**, **School Year**, **Start Date** and **End Date**.

Click **Save**.

Repeat for each student with Free/Reduced Meal eligibility.

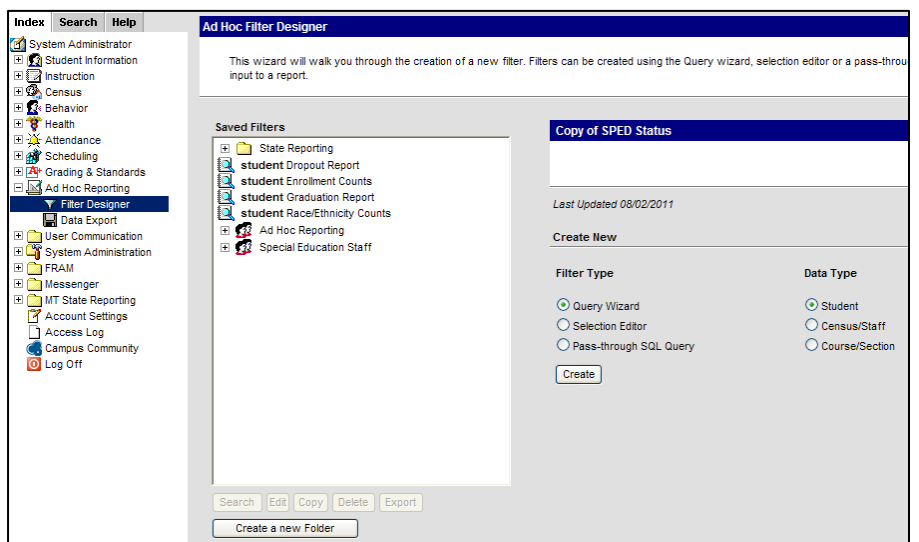


FREE/REDUCED MEAL REPORTS

Ad Hoc reports can be used to verify the accuracy of Free/Reduced Meal data entered into **FRAM**.

From the **Index**, expand **Ad Hoc Reporting**. Select **Filter Designer**.

Under **Create New**, select **Filter Type: Query Wizard** and **Data Type: Student**. Click **Create**.

Click **Save** or **Save & Test**.

Grouping and Aggregation of the data allows users to group results by type and produces a count of that type.

For example, Free/Reduced Meal counts can be grouped by *grade*, then *status* – producing a count of students with Free or Reduced by grade, then individual counts of both Free and Reduced.

Group the data into sections that can have aggregates/sub-totals

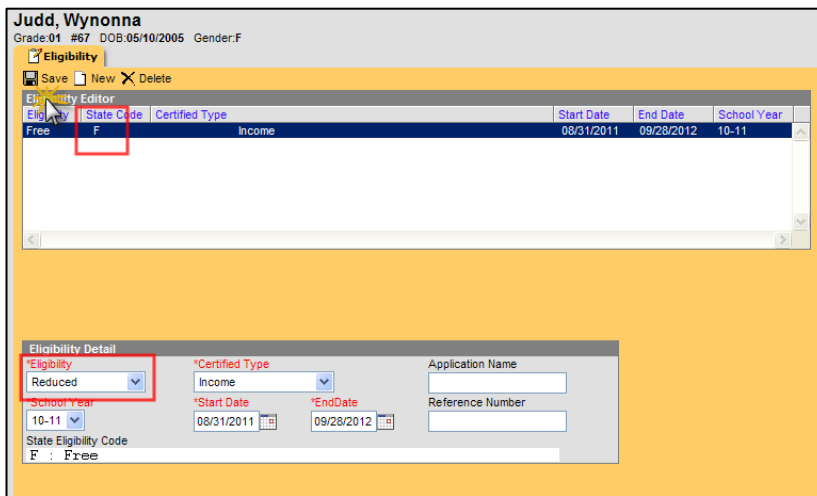
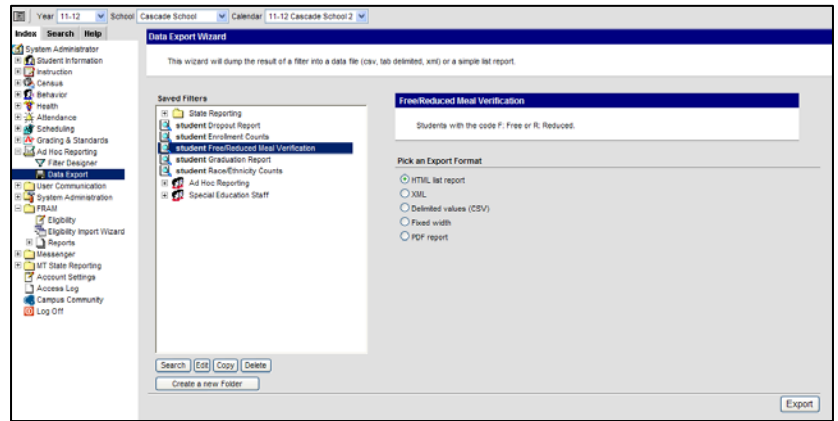

Expand **Ad Hoc Reporting** and select **Data Export**.

From **Saved Filters**, select **Free/Reduced Meal Verification**. Choose an **Export Format**.

Click **Export**.



Verify the numbers of students in each program type. If students are missing or have an incorrect eligibility, return to the **FRAM** module and make corrections to each student.
