

Application for Honorary High School Diploma for Montana WWII/Korean/Vietnam Veterans

Senate Bill 81 of the 2003 Montana Legislature

This application is used to establish the eligibility of an honorably discharged veteran for receipt of an honorary high school diploma from the State of Montana. The veteran must have actively served in the United States armed services during World War II from 1939 through 1947, during the Korean War from 1950 through 1953, or during the Vietnam War from 1961 through 1975. A honorary high school diploma does not replace a traditional high school or high school equivalency diploma, it is meant to provide special recognition for those who have served our country.

The completed application is to be returned to the Office of Public Instruction.

Introduction

The 2003 Montana Legislature enacted a bill to provide special recognition in the form of an Honorary High School Diploma to certain veterans. The State of Montana recognizes the important contributions and sacrifices veterans made in the defense of our nation in awarding this honor.

Honorary High School Diploma for Certain Veterans: Montana Code Annotated (Link) 2019

Eligibility

To be eligible for an Honorary Diploma, the veteran must meet all of the following requirements:

- 1. Be a current or former Montana resident
- 2. Did not receive a high school diploma
- 3. Actively served in the United States armed services during one of the following periods:
 - World War II from 1939 through 1947
 - Korean War from 1950 through 1953
 - Vietnam War from 1961 through 1975
- 4. Was honorably discharged; or was released from active duty because of a service-related disability

An immediate family member can apply on the veteran's behalf if he/she is deceased or incapacitated.

A copy of the veteran's discharge from military service indicating honorable service between the dates specified above must be provided.

The applicant's signature certifies the remaining information.

Replacement of Discharge Papers from Military Service

A veteran or next of kin may request a copy of the veteran's discharge from military service from the National Person-nel Records Center. All requests must be made in writing using Standard Form 180 "Request Pertaining to Military Records."
