Overview

What to Expect: A Typical 50-Minute Session Schedule:

- **(3 in) Welcome and Introductions**
- **(10 min or less) Ground Work**
 - Session Facilitators will provide professional learning and identify some key considerations within the topic for the task force.
 - Information will be highly concentrated with the assumption of strong background knowledge among the task force participants, while appropriate for various levels of experience and perspectives.
- **(7 min) Interactive Warm-Up Activity**
 - Opportunity for clarification, reflection, and synthesis. Small groups or whole group.
- **(5 min) Big Ideas**
 - The facilitator will provide additional learning or increase the complexity of considerations.
- **(20) Small group Breakouts**
 - Facilitators will lead grade band teams through a series of questions, visual stimuli, etc. that provide the framework for discussing issues, problems of practice, and standards development considerations.
- **(5 min) Reflection and So What**
 - Opportunity for task force members to collaborate on a shared document that will curate important standards revisions considerations identified by and prioritized by task force members from each session.
