HiSET At Home-Montana

17 & 18 Year Old Application

Applicants 17 & 18 years of age are eligible to take the High School Equivalency (HSE) exam using the remote proctored option (HiSET At Home) after one of following documents is presented to the HSE Program at the Montana Office of Public Instruction.

All documentation should be on official letterhead, signed in ink.

High School Equivalency Testing Administrative Rules of Montana (check box next to selection) :

10.66.112 QUALIFICATIONS - EXCEPTIONS

Candidates 17 and 18 years of age are eligible to test and receive HSE diplomas provided the candidate:

- 1. Submits to the HSE testing center prior to testing, an original, official school document that clearly identifies the candidate by name, date of birth, and provides the last school enrollment date and signed by the chief education officer verifying that the candidate has been advised of in-school and alternative educational options;** or resides in a Montana-based job corps center, correctional facility, state authorized group home, or treatment center and submits a written referral from the facility director or authorized agent (e.g., probation officer); and is no longer enrolled in a regular high school program for credit.
- 2. Candidates with no previous high school enrollment are required to provide documentation from a chief education officer or the county superintendent of the county in which the candidate currently resides, documenting the candidate has not enrolled in school and has been advised of in-school and alternative education options.**
