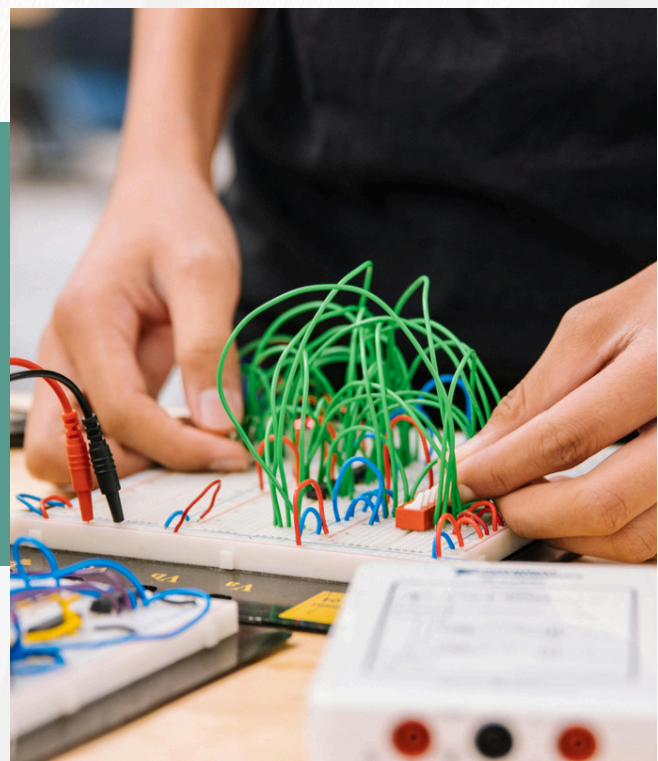


# MONTANA CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE) FACT SHEET

In honor of #MTCTEMonth, see the following information regarding CTE in Montana.



## STUDENT DATA:

- 3 in 4 Montana students enroll in CTE classes
- Over 9,500 students earn 2 or more CTE credits
- Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) members demonstrate CTE knowledge and leadership, as well as career-ready skills.

## STUDENT OUTCOMES:

- Student concentrators have the opportunity to earn post-secondary dual credit from Montana institutions while in high school.
- Industry recognized credentials are offered to CTE students to jump start their careers.
- The graduation rate of CTE students is 97.2% compared to 85.8% for all Montana students.

### 1. Aligns to industry through career connected education

Through advisory committees and industry partners, CTE brings technical knowledge and skills to Montana youth.

### 2. Connects the classroom to the real world

Continual professional development ensures teachers link real world skills, innovation and best practices into their classrooms.

Through CTSSO memberships, and authentic classroom experiences, employability skills are practiced and mastered.
