<p><b>Get the Facts</b> The Hospitality &amp; Tourism Career Cluster encompasses the management, marketing and operations of restaurants and other foodservices, lodging, attractions, recreation events and travel related services.</p> <p><b>Workforce Trends</b> Hospitality &amp; Tourism is Montana's second largest sector.
