

TUITION RATES SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025

Regular Tuition Agreement Rates per 20-5-323, MCA and 20-5-324, MCA

The OPI will calculate the percentages necessary to determine the tuition rate once all the budgets have been submitted in the fall. The percentages are calculated based on the adopted general fund budget funded by BASE and over-BASE property tax levies in the year of attendance not to exceed 35.3%. The tuition rate will be determined based upon the lowest percentage calculated between the District of Residence and the District of Attendance. The calculated tuition amount is to be entered into the appropriate box on the attendance agreement.

Calculation of Tuition to be charged:

Compare the rates for the two districts; choose the lower percentage. Multiply the Tuition per-ANB amount by the lower percentage. Equals Tuition Charged.

FY2025 Tuition Per-ANB Amounts:

\$ 3,365.27 for half-time kindergartners (KH) and Pre-K (PK) students with an IEP.

\$ 6,518.77 for full-time kindergartners (KF) and students in grades 1-8.

\$ 8,286.77 for grades 7-8 if the school runs an accredited 7-8 program or junior high.

\$ 8,286.77 for grades 9-12.

Amounts Used To Calculate Tuition Per-ANB Amount per <u>20-9-306, MCA</u>: FY2025 Maximum Tuition Per-ANB Amounts:

\$ 3,153.50 for half-time kindergartners (KH) and Pre-K (PK) students with an IEP.

\$ 6,307.00 for full-time kindergartners (KF) and students in grades 1-8.

\$ 8,075.00 for grades 7-8 if the school runs an accredited 7-8 program or junior high.

\$ 8,075.00 for grades 9-12.

FY 2025 Block Grant Rates:

\$ 158.83 Instructional Block Grant Rate per ANB.

\$ 52.94 Related Services Block Grant Rate per ANB.
