



Introduction

Early Targeted Intervention Data Collection #2

Per [20-7-1803, MCA](#), the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall monitor the Early Targeted Intervention Program and gather data to evaluate the efficacy of the interventions while protecting the privacy rights of students and families. **This data collection will focus on the classroom-based and home-based programs offered during the 25/26 school year.** Data about the Jumpstart program was collected within Data Collection #1 in the Fall of 2025.

District Representative

Trustees offering an Early Targeted Intervention shall closely monitor the program and report annually to the Superintendent of Public Instruction on the efficacy of the program no later than July

15. The report must include anonymized information on student progress, including the students' performance on (a) the evaluation methodology that led to eligibility for the program; (b) any formative assessments administered; (c) if administered, the evaluation methodology at the end of the school year in which intervention was provided.
