The local education agency (LEA) applications for reallocated funds will be ranked according to the percentage of children eligible for free/reduced lunch or milk. This percentage will be from the previous October and will be supplied by the School Foods Program office at the Office of Public Instruction. LEA's are encouraged to apply for only those amounts that are absolutely necessary for the operation of the program. The maximum amount for reallocated funds will be limited by multiplying \$100 times the number of free/reduced lunch/milk count. If an LEA has no free/reduced lunch/milk program, the state education agency (SEA) will substitute the LEA's most recent total formula count used for Title I, Part A allocations.

Districts are required to spend the reallocated funds according to the approved grant application. Any changes to the grant must be approved by the OPI Title I Director.
