Looking Ahead:

ESSER Grant Compliance:

- <u>Safe Return Plan</u> reviewed at least every 6 months, posted on District website after <u>public/meaningful</u> stakeholder engagement
- ARP ESSER Plan reviewed at least every 6 months, posted on District website after <u>public/meaningful</u> <u>stakeholder engagement</u>
- Final Expenditure Report (FER) due at end of each grant cycle
- Annual Federal Data Collection (how funds were used, amounts, etc) February March 2023

The **Annual Federal Data Collection process** will begin on February 1st, 2023 and data will be due to the OPI by March 31st, 2023. Be on the lookout for information from OPI regarding your districts' data reporting.

The **ESSER CRRSA II funding cycle** closes on September 30, 2023. You have about 8 months to spend down this grant. Cash Requests should be submitted no later than September 25, 2023. The Final Expenditure Report (FER) should be submitted no later than October 25, 2023.

The **ESSER ARP III funding cycle** closes on September 30, 2024. You have about 20 months to spend down this grant. Cash Requests should be submitted no later than September 25, 2024. The Final Expenditure Report (FER) should be submitted no later than October 25, 2024.




