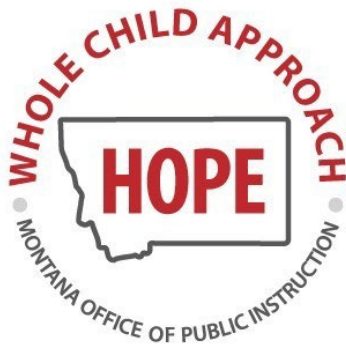




CSCT, Student Mental Health - Number of Schools on MOU Update
