# Smarter Balanced/MSA Completion Rates as of 4/17

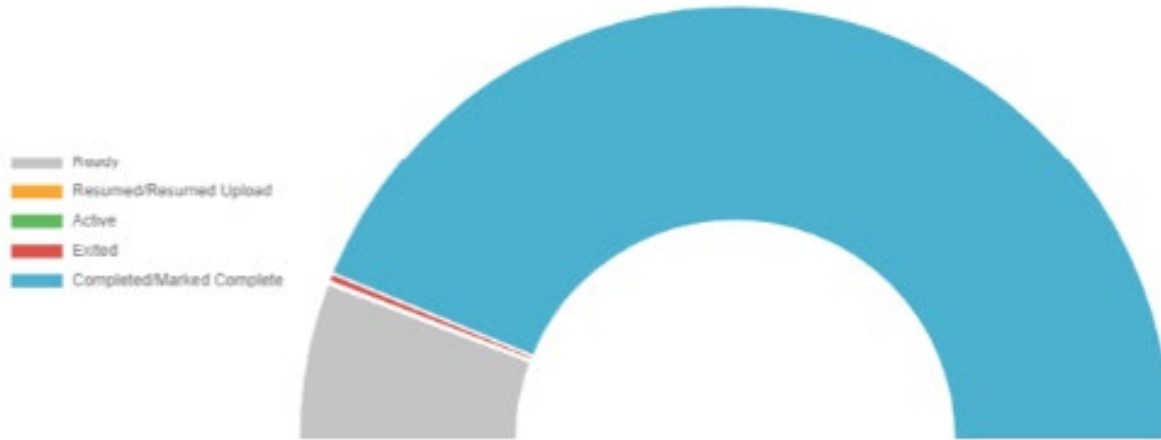


# AMSA/MSAA Completion Rates as of 4/17
