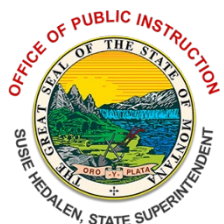

CTE COURSE DATA

Proper setup of CTE courses is essential both for Accreditation and for CTE Allocations. Allocations are based on Course Code, Educator assigned to the course, the credit awarded, the course minutes, Pathway assigned, and Work-Based Learning partner. Use the validations provided to ensure the course meets CTE requirements.

CTE COURSE SETUP

1. NCES Code (State Course Code) - Verify the Course Code is approved for CTE.
2. Available Carnegie Unit Credit – the amount of credit awarded for completion of a section (e.g., 0.5 = semester, 1.0 = full-year).
3. CTE Pathway – the Pathway(s) associated with the CTE Course (multiple select).
4. Work Based Learning/Partner - check if the CTE course qualifies as Work-Based Learning (requires a specific course code) and identify the Partner(s) for the course (multiple select).



CTE COURSE SETUP

5. Distance Class – check if the course is offered via remote instruction. The course should have a properly licensed and endorsed educator and a district facilitator.
6. Dual Credit – check if the course is offered for Dual Credit. The Class 8 instructor should be a properly licensed and endorsed educator. The educator should be an employee of the district or contracted educator and listed as Teacher of Record.



CTE VALIDATIONS

CTE Courses All Year With Class Minutes and Enroll Counts

- Shows CTE Course eligibility
- Shows assigned Pathway
- Shows Work-Based Learning and Partner
- Shows Dual Credit, Distance Learning and Alternative Education
- Shows Credit, Session Type
- Shows Course Minutes (8100 = full year, 4050 = Semester)
- Shows Educator and Role



CTE VALIDATIONS

CTE Students Rostered to Courses with Pathways Shows CTE Course eligibility

- By student report for credits earned.
- Shows Pathway credits per student.
- Use this report to update End of Year CTE information (2 or more credits in a single Pathway = CTE Concentrator).
