	 Our goal is to help automate as much as possible across systems Connected Intelligence: Data Lake Unified Insights: changing to Analytics and Insights Will provide data-driven insights into education for schools Using the data lake and Insights creates a more sustainable and modern system Screens in Insights will have nice graphics that can be customized to what schools need to see and have good visual tools to share as needed At the state level, it is important to note that all employees will not have access to all the data, just what we need to see for jobs We purchased student essentials, risk analysis, student readiness, and community engagement modules in Insights Community engagement specifically will hold all the same type of data at the state level as the current GEMS system, and the goal is that it will eventually replace GEMS Data visualizations on the secure dashboards will be data that is refreshed often to make this data more purposeful and usefu Mention: if you are a PS school that is on-prem, we will be building a VPN to tunnel to get data Because we aren't taking everything from their SIS, PS is building a custom connector to only gather compliance fields This data will eventually be pipelined into the data lake so that there isn't as much manual entry burden for schools. There is a recommendation that it might be a good route to go to do SFTP for data collection and reporting because PS can provide the stock power queries that can do a data pull and dump to make this process much smoother Data modernization is essentially doing two things: attempting to automate more of the data collection and providing more data for schools to use. The keys are going to be establishing those connections between the data systems at play for schools and OPI.
