

Indian Education for All Curriculum Mapping Template

This resource has examples of OPI IEFA lesson plans that can be taught throughout the school year in various content areas and grade levels.

The mapping template includes examples of monthly themes that could also be utilized for infusing relevant instruction throughout the school year.



This resource is just a sample, and it can provide staff with a place to start as you add in authentic lesson plans to fill in the gaps for the different grade levels and content areas.

With a map of what is being taught in hand, the entire school can begin to move forward on strategies to fill in gaps and enhance the level of implementation. You may consider the development of depth-of-study units that involve collaboration between teachers linked to specific grade level content.

At the end of the year, ask teachers to reflect on the difference between their intended curriculum and what they did, then set up a plan for the following year working to expand the content and level of integration and include more tribes or richer depth of study units employing tribal content.
