

## RECOMMENDATION FOR OFFICE OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION CAREER COACHES

- 1. Expand funding to support career coaches in 11 WIOA regions across the State
- 2. Hire coaches by the beginning of April so they can receive training, develop partnerships, help recruit students, businesses and industries in each region
- 3. Continue and expand working with schools, parents, counselors, students, businesses and industries to have students sign up for MT Ready by fall semester
- 4. Continue to collect data. Everything including and not limited to:
  - a. Number of students coached
  - b. Number of students registered for WBL
  - c. What CTE program or class they're wanting for credit(s)
  - d. How many credits, half-credits, etc.
  - e. How many are aligned or participating in a CTSO
  - f. What and how many businesses and industries are participating
- 5. Expand contacts with all participating districts and students throughout next school year
- 6. Expand partnership and continue to work collectively with the DLI Business and Education Engagement team and Apprenticeship program
- 7. Continue to work collaboratively with OCHE and 2-year colleges
- 8. Expand partnership and continue to work collaboratively with private sector businesses and associations and other partners

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
