• Chapter 55 (Accreditation of Schools)

- Negotiated Rule making is the process by which the rules are worked and consensus is
 used to determine any rule changes. The committee is working diligently to complete
 their work with four meetings remaining, in June.
 - The focus is shifting from minimum standards of quality to student learning outcomes.
 - The focus in some areas is shifting from ratios to the deliver of program standards that require the local districts to determine what is required in order to deliver a full program of services to students. There is not any elimination of key staff like counselors and librarians in this work, rather there is a focus on delivery of standards with equal access for all students.

• Workforce Redesign is underway at the OPI.

The Teacher Residency Demonstration Pilot is underway with 23 future teachers placed in the pilot. The key partner is the University of Montana Western. The residents (future teachers) will experience a full-year in a rural school district where they have been matched with a focus on outcomes that lead to highly effective teachers ready to engage learners from day 1, when they have their own classroom.
