



# Settings of Service for ages 5 and in Kindergarten thru 21

Code	Name	Short Description	Full Description
1	<b>Regular Class</b>	Inside the regular class 80% or more of the day	<p>Inside regular class 80% or more of day. These are children who received special education and related services outside the regular classroom for less than 21% of the school day. This may include children placed in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Regular class with special education/related services provided within regular classes</li> <li>• Regular class with special education/related services outside regular classes</li> <li>• Regular class with special education services provided in resource rooms</li> </ul>
2	<b>Part-time Special Education</b>	Inside the regular class between 40% and 79% of the day	<p>Inside regular class no more than 79% of day and no less than 40% of the day. These are children who received special education and related services outside the regular classroom for at least 21% but no more than 60% of the school day. Do not include children reported as receiving education programs in public or private separate school or residential facilities. This may include children placed in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• resource rooms with special education/related services provided within the resource room</li> <li>• resource rooms with part-time instruction in a regular class</li> </ul> <p><u>Do not include students who are reported as receiving education programs in public or private separate day schools or residential facilities.</u></p>
3	<b>Full-time Special Education</b>	Inside the regular class less than 40% of the day	<p>Inside regular class less than 40% of the day (RC39). These are children who received special education and related services outside the regular classroom for more than 60% of the school day. Do not include children who are reported as receiving education programs in public or private separate school or residential facilities. This may include children placed in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• self-contained special classrooms with part-time instruction in a regular class</li> <li>• self-contained special classrooms with full-time special education instruction on a regular school campus</li> </ul> <p><u>Do not include students reported as receiving education programs in public or private separate day schools or residential facilities.</u></p>
8	<b>Homebound/Hospitals</b>	Homebound/Hospital	<p>These are children who received programs in homebound/hospital environments. This includes children receiving special education and related services in hospital programs or homebound programs. Do not include children whose parents have opted to home-school them and who receive special education at the public expense.</p>



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9	<b>Correctional Facilities</b>	Correctional Facility	Students who receive special education in correctional facilities. This is intended to be a count of all students receiving special education in short-term detention facilities (community-based or residential), or correctional facilities.
10	<b>Private Schools (parentally placed)</b>	Parentally placed in private schools	<p>These are children who are enrolled by their parents or guardians in regular parochial or other private schools and whose basic education is paid for through private resources and who receive special education and related services at public expense from a local educational agency or intermediate educational unit under a services plan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Include children whose parents chose to home-school them, but who receive special education and related services at the public expense.</li> <li>• Do not include children who are placed in private schools by the LEA.</li> </ul>
21	<b>Separate Day School (public/private)</b>	<b>Separate day school</b>	<p>These are children who received education programs in public or private separate day school facilities. This includes children with disabilities receiving special education and related services, at public expense, for greater than 50% of the school day in public or private separate schools. This may include children placed in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• public and private day schools for students with disabilities</li> <li>• public and private day schools for students with disabilities for a portion of the school day (greater than 50%) and in regular school buildings for the remainder of the school day</li> <li>• public and private residential facilities if the student does not live at the facility</li> </ul>
22	<b>Residential Facility (public/private)</b>	<b>Residential Facility</b>	<p>These are children who received education programs and lived in public or private residential facilities during the school week. This includes children with disabilities receiving special education and related services, at public expense, for greater than 50% of the school day in public or private residential facilities. This may include children placed in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• public and private residential schools for students with disabilities</li> <li>• public and private residential schools for students with disabilities for a portion of the school day (greater than 50%) and in separate day schools or regular school buildings for the remainder of the school day</li> </ul> <p>Do not include students who received education programs at the facility, but do not live there.</p>
