


Alcohol and Other Drug Use Maps



County-Level Data




Percentage of Montana High School students. . . Had first drink of alcohol before age 13 years




Currently drank alcohol, past 30 days




Binge drank, past 30 days (4 or more drinks if female, 5 or more drinks if male, in a row, within a couple of hours)




Drank more than 10 alcoholic drinks, within a couple hours, past 30 days




Usually obtained the alcohol they drank by someone giving it to them, past 30 days




Usually drank beer when drinking alcohol, past 30 days




Have ever used marijuana in their lifetime




Tried marijuana before age 13 years




Currently used marijuana, past 30 days




Have ever used synthetic marijuana in their lifetime




Ever used cocaine in their lifetime (including powder, crack, or freebase).




Ever used inhalants in their lifetime (sniffed glue, breathed the contents of aerosol spray cans, or inhaled any paints or sprays to get high).




Ever used heroin in their lifetime (also called smack, junk, or China White).




Ever used methamphetamines in their lifetime (also called speed, crystal meth, crank, ice, or meth).
