Spring 2018 Competition Details:

- Grants awarded on a 5-year cycle with annual renewals
- Applicants=**40**
- Funded applicants=**16 Grantees, 48 Centers**
- Dollar Amount of Requests: **\$7,472,300.00**
- Dollar Amount Funded: **\$3,038,425.00**

What Changed from Previous Years?

- Every Student Succeeds Act drove more integration with other Title Programs
- Alignment with School Improvement Plans/Comprehensive Needs Assessment
- Priority Points for grantees serving Targeted or Comprehensive Schools by OPI
- OPI encouraged consortia to offer services to small/rural districts without capacity to run full programs on their own
- Larger awards were made based on the requirements
- Coordination with Governor Bullock's Office to review grant applications
- Scoring was conducted by Montana Tech as a 3rd party contractor (3 readers per application)
- Opportunity to learn from scoring and apply next year
- Programs cannot generate program income through fees or other sources
