Review of Modernization Project

- [Modernization Project Status Presentation](#)
 - Is Infinite Campus going away?
 - No. The systems that we currently have will stay intact. About half of the districts in MT use Infinite Campus and will not be required to change.
 - Data Lake technology will enable OPI to process data from different sources.
 - If a district is PowerSchool currently, but decided the district would like to transfer to Infinite Campus, they will have the ability to do so.
 - When will this information be rolled out to the Superintendents in the MASS meetings?
 - OPI can provide a presentation at any one of the MASS meetings if we are invited to do so.
 - Communication has also gone out in the OPI Compass over the past several months.
 - Rep. Fred Anderson comments that this work encapsulates the wishes and design of Legislation.
