Education and Workforce Data Governing Board	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Result of HB 949</li> <li>• Looks at data governance issues related to workforce and education data</li> <li>• Hosted by Department of Administration with multiple other agencies represented</li> <li>• Next meeting March 7, 2024</li> </ul>
Steering Committee	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There is a steering committee of school data and technology staff for the OPI Data Modernization project</li> <li>• This group is looking at PowerSchool’s Analytics and Insights tool along with data collection processes</li> </ul>
Data Modernization	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• PowerSchool is the Data Modernization project vendor</li> <li>• Infinite Campus will still be the state SIS</li> <li>• Data Modernization will help to automate data flow between systems and make data more timely and actionable</li> <li>• A connection has been established between the state data lake and the PowerSchool data lake</li> </ul>

TMT and Accreditation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teach MT (TMT) is the teacher licensure system</li> <li>• RANDA also provides the state accreditation system</li> <li>• Accountability data and report cards should be ready by the end of March to go out to schools</li> <li>• Accountability data and report cards will be publicly available in early April</li> </ul>
Survey Tool	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Qualtrics is our survey tool</li> <li>• We have been using Qualtrics for the Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA), deployed in September 2023</li> <li>• We have received over 12,000 responses from across the state</li> </ul>
Data Collections	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The spring ANB collection was the smoothest collection we have seen yet!</li> </ul>
Next Steps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Collections throughout the year were difficult with the new processes in place</li> <li>• We are doing open “office hours” to help schools</li> <li>• We hope to attend other gatherings throughout the state through the summer to help provide additional information and clarification for schools</li> <li>• We are continuing to prepare, QA, and submit data as required</li> </ul>
