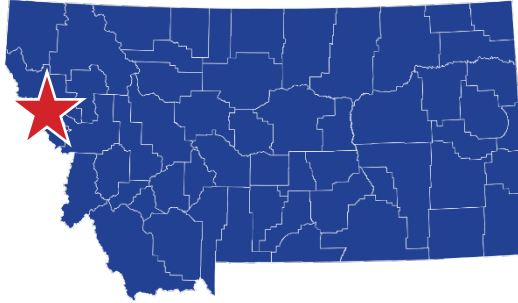

Program Description:

The Alberton Afterschool program has a high participation rate of students, mostly in elementary school. With a good level of student engagement averaging 7 hours per week of programming.

One outcome of the Panther Program that was evident, outside of student academic levels, is a clear understanding of local programming and businesses. With a heavy focus in community engagement, students were able to participate in several opportunities like learning about the public library system and local environmental community organizations.

The Panther Program offered free to all Alberton students provides youth with an opportunity for a safe space to engage in play-based learning to increase student proficiencies in math and reading. The small teacher-to-student ratios have allowed for hands-on learning experiences while striving for student gains in math and reading proficiencies.

Student Gains:

- 5% gain in student ELA proficiency
- 5% gain in student math proficiency
- Student attendance increase to 92%
