

WHAT?

The Montana School Computer Program is administered by the OPI and collects computer equipment from state and federal sources, and private donations to distribute at no cost to Montana's K-12 public schools.

HOW?

The inventory of surplus equipment varies from day to day. The program maintains a waiting list of schools interested in equipment and schools are contacted about their eligibility. Contact OPI to seek information, put your school's name on the waiting list, or to check the availability of equipment.

WHERE?

Schools are responsible for traveling to Clancy, MT to retrieve equipment and must have an appointment.
