Instructional Testing Cycle





- Testlets should be administered as close to instruction as possible
- Spread out testing throughout the window instead of testing all testlets in a week
- All scheduled testing must be completed in the window (cannot be moved to next window)
- Plan for make ups

Administration Best Practice

- MAST testing should be in a student's regular instructional/testing setting when appropriate and mirror regular classroom assessment administration as much as possible
- Only instructional materials and displays that provide students with an unfair advantage on tested content need to be removed or covered (*ex: a visual support of long division when students are taking a Multi-Digit Division testlet*)
- Make-up testing can happen within the regular classroom as long as the environment is quiet, instruction is not occurring and test security is possible

Monitoring Testlet Completion

Once in the Monitor Screen:

- 1. Select the three dots to filter in the "Overall Status" column. Choose Sort Descending.
- 2. This will pull testlets to the top that are "Unused" (student has not started), "In Progress" (student has started but hasn't completed), or "Paused" (student has not completed).
- 3. Look to the associated Student Name for which students still need to complete testlets.
- 4. Repeat steps #1-3 for the other testlets in the Monitor Screen.
