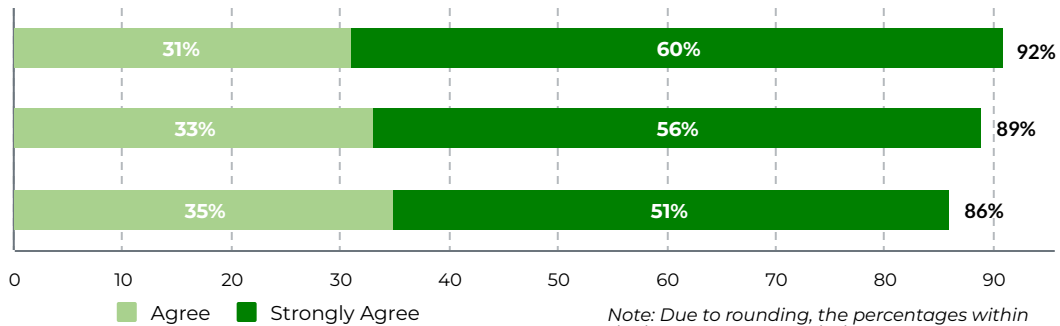

Survey Item Results

On 9 of the 10 items, 78% or more of the parents had positive responses.

The three highest-rated items:

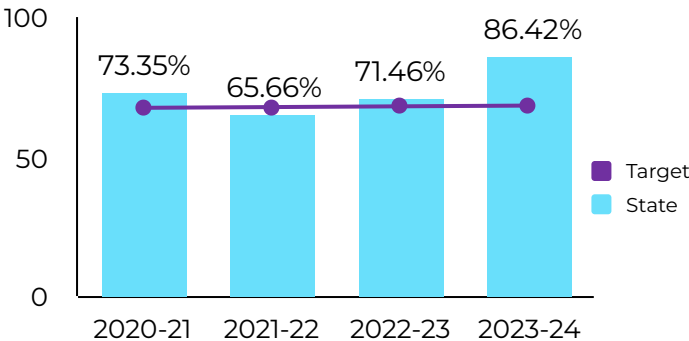
- 5. The evaluation report and/or IEP meeting was scheduled at a mutually agreed upon time and location.
- 7. The communication and documentation I receive is understandable, and I have the opportunity to ask questions if I need more information.
- 2. I have been involved in decision-making processes related to my child's special education services, and the team values my input and ideas.
