

Special Education Data Collection/Verification Timelines

Timelines for collections/verifications/information from the Special Education Data Unit:

- July
 - Respond to questions on Behavior data submission if needed
 - Respond to questions on Exiting data submission if needed
- August
 - Post School Survey Data Collection – this is the data that we collect and use for Indicator 14 of the Annual Performance Report
 - Open mid-April to September 30

 - Levels of Determination – these determinations are made on a districts performance on several key indicators in the State Performance Plan/Annual Performance Report

 - Child Count Verification – the official count date is the 1st Monday of October, but the application will open in mid-September to allow ample time to make any corrections that are needed prior to that.
 - Verification of users starts approximately September 10
 - Open approximately September 15 to October 31

 - Behavior Data Collection – this is a collection of ALL students who have an out of school suspension or expulsion, and any special education students who have an in-school suspension. Typically this is a collection done by superintendents and principals. Data collection done through the AIM Behavior Module
