Eligibility for Incentive Pay

- 1. You must create an <u>LRP account</u> and designate your role as **Paraeducator participating in the SPED Technician Track**.
- 2. Public school employment working with students with disabilities will be verified using this form.
- 3. Dawson Community College will collect a W-9 and other necessary information to make payments.
- 4. Incentive Pay is for a specific list of 40 specific LRP courses at a rate of \$20/module not to exceed \$800 per paraeducator.
