



SY2024 OPI Assessment Focused Webinar Registration

The Assessment Unit offers a 1-hour webinar once a month from September to June annually for a total of 10 webinars during the school year. These focused webinars are designed to support educational practitioners involved in managing district assessments, accountability, and reporting requirements under state and federal law.

Webinars include a 30–40-minute presentation on a time-sensitive assessment topic, a 15 minute “Learning Lab” demonstration of a key assessment task, and end with time for participants to ask the OPI Assessment Team any questions pertaining to state assessments.
