











Percentage of Montana High School students. . . Never or rarely wore a seat belt when riding in a car








Rode with someone who had been drinking alcohol, past 30 days












Never or rarely wore a seat belt when driving a car, past 30 days






Drove a car or other vehicle when they had been drinking alcohol, past 30 days






Texted or e-mailed while driving, past 30 days






Used the Internet or apps on their cell phone (such as YouTube, Instagram, or Facebook) while driving, past 30 days







Carried a weapon such as a gun, knife, or club on school property, past 30 days






Carried a gun during the past 12 months (do not count hunting or for a sport, such as target shooting)






Did not go to school because they felt unsafe at school or on their way to or from school, past 30 days






Were threatened or injured with a weapon such as a gun, knife, or club on school property, past 12 months






Were in a physical fight, past 12 months






Were in a physical fight on school property, past 12 months






Were ever physically forced to have sexual intercourse when they did not want to






Were forced to do sexual things such as kissing, touching, or sexual intercourse when they did not want to, past 12 months






Sexual Dating Violence - among dating students, were forced to do sexual things that they did not want to do (e.g., kissing, touching, or forced sexual intercourse)






Physical Dating Violence - among dating students, were physically hurt on purpose (e.g., being hit, slammed into something, or injured with an object or weapon)






Were bullied on school property, past 12 months

(Data skip in the 40-percentile range)






Were electronically bullied (e.g., texting, Instagram, Facebook, or other social media), past 12 months










Felt so sad or hopeless for two weeks or more in a row they stopped doing usual activities, past 12 months




Seriously considered attempting suicide, past 12 months






Made a plan about how they would attempt suicide, past 12 months
