Bullying Depression Suicide Ideation 41% of students felt so sad or hopeless 16% of high school students had 22% of students seriously considered been bullied on school property almost every day for two weeks or more attempting suicide during the past 12 months in a row that they stopped doing usual during the past 12 months activities 16% had been electronically 18% of students made a plan about how they bullied (texting, Instagram, would attempt suicide Facebook, or other social media) during the past 12 months 10% of students actually attempted suicide 14% of students had been the victim of teasing or name calling Among students who attempted suicide, 32% had a suicide attempt that because someone thought they were resulted in an injury, poisoning, or overdose that had to be treated by a doctor gay, lesbian or bisexual (GLB) or nurse
