<p>28% had ever tried cigarette smoking</p> <p>10% had first tried cigarette smoking before age 13 years</p> <p>7% of students currently smoked cigarettes/past 30 days</p> <p>1% of students had smoked cigarettes on 20 or more of the past 30 days</p> <p>Among current smokers, 4% smoked more than 10 cigarettes per day (past 30 days)</p>	<p>5% of students had used chewing tobacco, snuff, dip, snus, or dissolvable tobacco products during the past 30 days</p> 	 <p>48% of students had ever used electronic vapor products</p> <p>10% of students used electronic vapor products on 20 or more of the past 30 days</p> <p>7% of students used electronic vapor products daily</p> <p>13% of students used electronic vapor products on school property during the past 30 days</p>
