



Seatbelt Use

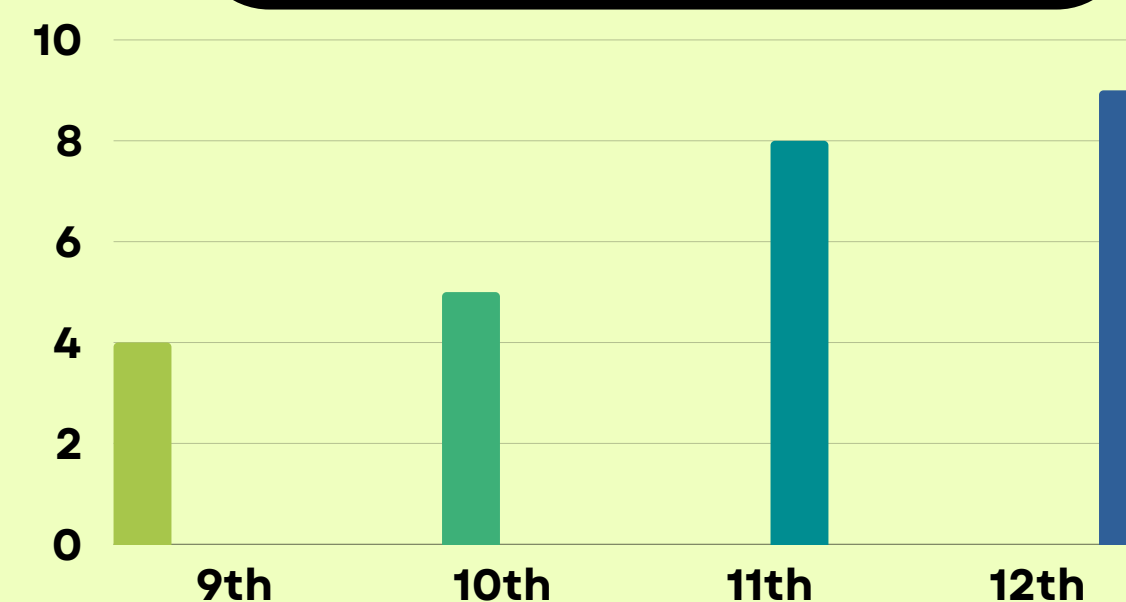
- 49% of students always wear a seat belt when riding in a car; 9% report never or rarely wearing a seat belt
- Among drivers, 9% never or rarely wear a seat belt when driving; 65% always wear a seat belt when driving
- 40% of males and 29% of females did not always wear a seat belt when driving

MONTANA STUDENT DRIVING BEHAVIORS

Alcohol and Driving

- 21% of students rode with a driver who had been drinking alcohol during the past 30 days
- 7% of students drove when they had been drinking alcohol during the past 30 days

Distracted Driving



- 57% of students who drove a car during the past 30 days texted or e-mailed while driving
- 53% of students who drove a vehicle during the past 30 days used the Internet or Apps on their cell phone while driving

Rode with a driver who had been drinking alcohol



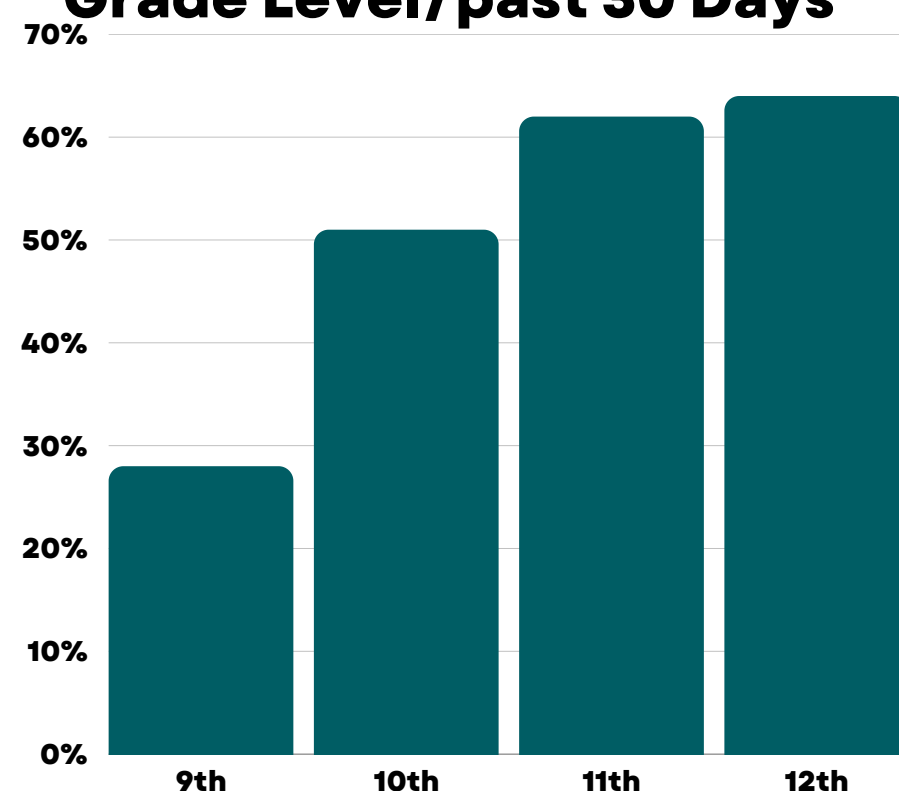
